ABOUT

The island of Singapore was known to mariners at least by the third century A.D. By the seventh century, when a succession of maritime states arose throughout the Malay Archipelago, Singapore probably was one of the many trading outposts serving as an entrepôt and supply point for Malay, Thai, Javanese, Chinese, Indian, and Arab traders.

In 1819 Sir Thomas Stamford Raffles established Singapore as a free-trade post (at the time Singapore had 1000 inhabitants). Over the next hundred years Singapore became a leading trade and labour port. After becoming independent from Malaysia in 1965 Singapore has experienced sustained economic and trade success, bringing people from all corners of the globe to live, invest and start businesses.

Now, Singapore an international melting pot of languages, religions, and cultures - it's an incredibly interesting and engaging city with beautiful sites and activities at every turn, and it's the perfect setting for this year's Principal Advance.

Population: 5.607 million

Currency: Singapore Dollar SGD\$100 is equal to AUD\$99.46

Country Code: +65

Climate: Tropical climate with high humidity. Expect 26 - 32 degrees in June.

Official Language: English, Malay, Mandarin Chinese, and Tamil. English is the common language.

Main Religion: Buddhism (33%), Christianity, Islam, Taoism, and Hinduism.

Passport and Visa: Your passport must have at least 6 months validity beyond your date of departure and if you're an Australian or New Zealand passport holders you do not need a visa to enter (please check if you hold a passport from another country prior to departure).

Tax Refund: Tourists can claim a refund on the 7% Goods and Services Tax (GST) paid on your purchases if you spend more than \$100 at any participating shops.

Power Plug: The standard electrical current used in Singapore is 220-240 volts AC (50 cycles) and you can use power plugs with three square prongs here.

No Smoking Areas: You are not allowed to smoke in all air-conditioned places, such as malls and eateries. There are designated smoking areas in some entertainment outlets and open-air eateries.



Singapore has the world's highest percentage of millionaires, with one out of every six households having at least one million US dollars in disposable wealth. Wowsa!

2

Singapore Changi Airport hosts a network of over 100 airlines connecting Singapore to some 300 cities in about 70 countries and territories worldwide. It has been rated one of the best international airports by international travel magazines!

90.3% of resident households (i.e. households headed by a Singapore citizen or permanent resident) own the homes they live in, and the average household size is 3.43 persons (which include dependants who are neither citizens nor permanent residents).

You might not know it but Singapore's land area includes as many as 62 offshore islands that surround the main island. These include Sentosa (the largest of the 62 offshore islands), Pulau Ubin, St John's Island and Sisters' Islands. What that means for visitors: more fun in the sun!

Singapore is one of the world's greenest cities! Nearly half of Singapore's land area (approximately 700 square kilometres) is under green cover. Beyond numerous parks and gardens, there are pockets of undiscovered plant life housed in the most unusual of places.

Singapore: The Lion City

You may have heard about the Merlion, Singapore's iconic emblem. The Merlion is a mythical creature with a lion's head and a fish's tail. What you might not know: the Merlion was partly inspired by the city's Sanskrit name, Singapura, which means 'lion city'.
